



Make an Easter Chick

WORKSHEET



You will need:

- | | |
|----------------------------|----------------------|
| Cardboard eggshell section | Orange card or paper |
| Yellow wool | Scissors |
| A piece of thin card | Glue |
| White paper | |

What you do...

1. Cut two circles with a diameter of 6 cm from the thin card.
2. Cut a hole in the centre of each one with a diameter of 3 cm. This will make two rings.

3. Put the two rings together and start winding the yellow wool around both as shown. Keep winding until the hole in the middle is almost completely filled.

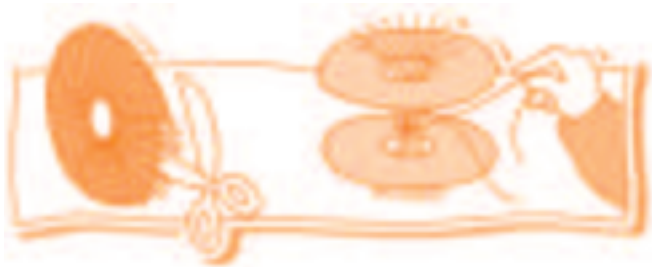
4. Cut the wool around the circumference and then tie a length of wool tightly around the middle between the two card circles.



5. Gently pull off the card circles and fluff out the wool to make a pom pom.

6. Make two small circle eyes from the white paper and a small triangle orange beak from the card. Stick on with glue to make the chick's face.

7. Sit the pom pom chick inside the cardboard eggshell section.



To the Teacher

To make this into a listen and do activity, make the chick with the children using these simple English instructions:

|-------------------------|-----------------------------|
| Draw circles. | Take off the card. |
| Cut out the circles. | Make a fluffy ball. |
| Wind the wool around. | Make eyes and a beak. |
| Cut the wool here. | Stick on the eyes and beak. |
| Tie the wool like this. | Put the chick in the egg. |
